# SPECIALTY QUANTITY LIMIT PROGRAM

# **OTREXUP** (methotrexate injection)

## I. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The standard limit is designed to allow a quantity sufficient for the most common uses of the medication. The recommended dosing parameters for all FDA-approved indications fall within the standard limits. Coverage of an additional quantity may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis upon request.

### **II. COVERED QUANTITIES**
