SABRIL (vigabatrin)

I. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The standard limit is designed to allow a quantity sufficient for the most common uses of the medication. The recommended dosing parameters for all FDA-approved indications fall within the standard limits. Coverage of an additional quantity may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis upon request.

II. COVERED QUANTITIES

Sabril (vigabatrin) 500 mg tablet	daily); increase total daily dose weekly in 500 mg/day increments, to the recommended dose of 3000 mg/day (1500 mg twice daily) • Pediatric (10 to 16 years of age) – Initiate at 500 mg/day (250 mg twice daily); increase total daily dose weekly in 500 mg/day increments, to recommended maintenance dose of 2000 mg/day (1000 mg twice daily); dose patients weighing more than 60 kg according to adult recommendations Infantile Spasms: • Initiate at a daily dose of 50 mg/kg (25 mg/kg twice daily); increase total daily dose every 3 days, in increments of 25 mg/kg/day to 50 mg/kg/day, up to a maximum daily dose of 150 mg/kg (75 mg/kg twice daily)	180 per 30 days
