# SPECIALTY QUANTITY LIMIT PROGRAM

## **SUTENT** (sunitinib malate)

#### I. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The standard limit is designed to allow a quantity sufficient for the most common uses of the medication. The recommended dosing parameters for all FDA-approved indications fall within the standard limits. Coverage of an additional quantity may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis upon request.

## **II. COVERED QUANTITIES**

Sutent (sunitinib malate) capsule 37.5 mg	30 per 30 days
