SPECIALTY GUIDELINE MANAGEMENT

TRELSTAR (triptorelin pamoate)

POLICY

I. INDICATIONS

The indications below including FDA-approved indications and compendial uses are considered a covered benefit provided that all the approval criteria are met and the member has no exclusions to the prescribed therapy.

- A. <u>FDA-Approved Indication</u> Palliative treatment of advanced prostate cancer
- B. <u>Compendial Use</u> Prostate Cancer Preservation of ovarian function

All other indications are considered experimental/investigational and not medically necessary.

II. CRITERIA FOR INITIAL APPROVAL

A. Prostate cancer

Authorization of 12 months may be granted for treatment of prostate cancer.

B. Preservation of ovarian function

Authorization of 3 months may be granted for preservation of ovarian function when the member is premenopausal and undergoing chemotherapy.

III. CONTINUATION OF THERAPY

A. Prostate cancer

Authorization of 12 months may be granted for continued treatment in members requesting reauthorization who are experiencing clinical benefit to therapy (e.g., serum testosterone less than 50 ng/dL) and who have not experienced an unacceptable toxicity.

B. Preservation of ovarian function

Authorization of 3 months may be granted for continued treatment for preservation of ovarian function in members requesting reauthorization who are premenopausal and are still undergoing chemotherapy.
